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Featured Stamp Set: Perfectly Plaid #158335

Additional supplies used:

- 155574 Evening Evergreen Cardstock (5 ½" x 8 ½", score 4 ¼"), (4 ¾" x 2 ¼"), (2 ½" x 2 ½")
- 155776 Soft Succulent Cardstock (4" x 5 ¼"), (2 ½" x 2 ½")
- 159276 Basic White Cardstock (2 ¼" x 2 ¼"), (3 ½" x 1 ½")
- 155718 Tidings of Christmas DSP 4 ½" x 2"
- 155576 Evening Evergreen Classic Stampin' Pad
- 147114 Early Espresso Classic Stampin' Pad

Instructions:

1. Fold and burnish scored Evening Evergreen card base at 4 ¼"
2. Run 4" x 5 ¼" Soft Succulent card panel through the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine using the Bark 3D embossing folder.
3. Cut circle out of 2 ¼" x 2 ¼" Basic White cardstock using 2 1/8" circle die and the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine.
4. Cut scalloped circle out of 2 ½" x 2 ½" Soft Succulent cardstock using 2 ¼" scalloped die.
5. Stamp tree image in Evening Evergreen onto Basic White Circle. Stamp tree trunk in Early Espresso.
6. Adhere Basic White circle to scalloped circle using Stampin' Seal.
7. Put a strip of Stampin' Seal on the back of the scalloped circle, then adhere gold Simply Elegant Trim in form you desire. Add Stampin' Dimensionals and adhere to 2 ½" x 2 ½" Evening Evergreen square.
8. Adhere DSP to 4 ¾" x 2 ¼" Evening Evergreen cardstock using Stampin' Seal. Then adhere panel to embossed panel on left side using Stampin' Seal.
9. Adhere tree panel as shown using Stampin' Seal.
10. Stamp sentiment onto 3 ½" x 1 ½" Basic White cardstock in Evening Evergreen. Die cut sentiment using 3 ¼" x 1 ¼" Stitched Rectangle Die. Adhere to card front using Stampin' Seal.
11. Stamp tree image onto front of envelope.
12. Enjoy!

Optional: The tree image can be punched out using the Pine Tree Punch and adhered back in place using Stampin' Dimensionals for a raised look.
