Featured Stamp Set: Frosted Gingerbread Bundle #156807 or Frosted Gingerbread Stamp Set #156314

Additional supplies used:

- 100702 Old Olive Cardstock (5 ½" x 8 ½", score 4 ¼")
- 159276 Basic White Cardstock (5 ¼" x 4"), (2 ¼" x 1 ½")
- 156457 Silver Foil Specialty Paper (4 ½" x 2 ¼") score 3/8" on both ends
- 156313 Gingerbread & Peppermint DSP (5 ½" x 1 ½"), (1/2" x 4 ½"), 2 cookie shapes
- 147084 Real Red Classic Stampin' Pad
- 156323 Real Red Mini Ruffled Ribbon 6" & 8"
- 146924 Red Rhinestone Basic Jewels
- 146320 Detailed Trio Punch
- 150664 Ornate Frames (for label)
- 118484 Clear Block E for sentiment
- 152392 Paper Trimmer
- 103579 Paper Snips
- 152813 Stampin' Seal
- 104430 Stampin' Dimensionals
- 103683 Mini Glue Dots
- 149653 Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine
- 159236 Basic White Medium Envelopes



Instructions:

1. Fold and burnish scored Old Olive card base at 4 ¼"
2. Wrap 6" of red ribbon around bottom ¼" green polka-dot DSP and adhere on the back with Stampin' Seal.
3. Adhere polka-dot DSP to bottom ¼" of Old Olive card base front using Stampin' Seal.
4. Using the Detailed Trio Punch, round corners of the Silver Foil piece. Lift end flaps slightly on score lines to form cookie sheet. Adhere to card front using Stampin' Dimensionals.
5. Fussy cut cookie shapes of choice from DSP using Paper Snips. Adhere to cookie sheet using Stampin' Dimensionals.
6. Place Red Rhinestones as shown.
7. Tie bow using 8" red ribbon and adhere to right of cookie sheet using a glue dot.
8. Stamp sentiment onto small Basic White piece in Real Red ink. Run sentiment using the label die through Stampin' Cut & Emboss machine. Adhere to upper left corner of card front using Stampin' Seal.
9. Stamp sentiment of choice to inside Basic White panel and adhere to inside of card.
10. Adhere skinny DSP strip to left side of Basic White Envelope using Stampin' Seal.
11. Enjoy!
