### Featured Stamp Set: **Be Jolly #156370**

#### Additional supplies used:

- 159276 Basic White Cardstock (3 ¼" x 2"), (3" x 2 ½")
- 156313 Gingerbread & Peppermint DSP (1 - 6" x 6" DSP per candy bar)
- 155560 Scalloped Contours Dies
- 132708 Tuxedo Black Memento Ink Pad
- 154899 Real Red Stampin' Blends
- 154885 Granny Apple Green Stampin' Blends
- 154883 Daffodil Delight Stampin' Blends
- 154903 Shaded Spruce Stampin' Blends
- 154886 Gray Granite Stampin' Blends
- 154893 Petal Pink Stampin' Blends
- 154848 Basic Black Stampin' Blends
- 144607 Bronze Stampin' Blend
- 141897 Clear Wink of Stella Glitter Brush
- 156323 Real Red Mini Ruffled Ribbon 20"

## Instructions:

1. Using the scoring blade on your Paper Trimmer, Score DSP at ½" on left side. If your DSP is directional, make sure to score it vertically.
2. Fold and burnish score line. Wrap DSP around Hershey bar then glue single edge to folded edge making sure edges are flush. Pinch folded edge slightly if too "poufy" around candy bar.
3. Wrap 20" of red ribbon around candy bar and tie into a bow.
4. Using the 2<sup>nd</sup> smallest die, cut "tag" in Basic White from Scalloped Contours Dies on the Stampin' Cut & Emboss machine.
5. Stamp image onto 3" x 2 ½" Basic White cardstock. Color in with the Stampin' Blends as shown, then fussy cut image using the Paper Snips.
6. Stamp sentiments onto the tags (the bird is stamped on the sleigh tag then colored with the Blends).
7. Adhere images to tags using Stampin' Dimensionals.
8. Using the pointed side of your Take Your Pick Tool, poke a small hole at the top of the tag. Thread white baker's twine through hole and around center of red bow, Tie twine into a bow and trim ends if needed.
9. Use Wink of Stella where you want to see a little sparkle!
10. Enjoy!

Tips: For the tree, stamp the small star separately, color with Daffodil Delight blends, fussy cut, then adhere to top of tree with a mini Stampin' Dimensional.

Make multiples of the tags to bundle and give as gifts, or use them on your gifts this year!
