Featured Stamp Set: Sweet Little Stockings #156282

Additional supplies used:

- 159229 Thick Basic White Cardstock (11" x 4 1/4", scored at 2 1/4" and 5 1/2" on long side)
- 159276 Basic White Cardstock (3 1/4" x 1 7/8")
- 102482 Real Red Cardstock (4" x 2 ¾")
- 153492 Heartwarming Hugs DSP (4" x 3"), 2 @ (4" x 2"), (1/4" x 4 1/2")
- 132708 Memento Tuxedo Black Ink Pad
- 154899 Real Red Stampin' Blends
- 154892 Old Olive Stampin' Blends
- 153535 Real Red Sheer Ribbon 12" cut in half lengthwise
- 155560 Scalloped Contours Dies 3rd largest
- 151770 Layering Circles Dies 2nd and 3rd smallest
- 117147 Clear Block B
- 118490 Clear Block H
- 152392 Paper Trimmer
- 103579 Paper Snips
- 152813 Stampin' Seal
- 103683 Mini Glue Dots
- 110755 Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- 149653 Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine
- 159236 Basic White Medium Envelopes



Instructions:



- 1. Fold and burnish scored Thick Basic White Cardstock at 2 ¼" and 5 ½".
- 2. Using Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, die cut half circle from small flap of cardbase using 2nd smallest circle die.
- 3. Without adhering, place 4" x 2" DSP to front of flap like you were adhering in place, making sure entire card is laying flat. Feel for circle cut out and using a pencil, mark about 1/8" down and to the sides of the opening. This is where you will place the 3rd largest circle die and cut. Adhere to FRONT of flap using Stampin' Seal.
- 4. Using Multipurpose Liquid Glue, glue the sides only of the gift card flap, fold in and press down.
- 5. Adhere 4" x 3" DSP to front of card base using Stampin' Seal.
- 6. Adhere 4" x 2" DSP to front of card base on the right side using Stampin' Seal.
- 7. Stamp inside sentiment using Memento Tuxedo Black Ink Pad.
- 8. Stamp sentiment and present onto 3 ½" x 1 7/8" Basic White card stock using Memento Tuxedo Black Ink Pad. Color present with Stampin' Blends.
- 9. Die cut 4" x 2 3/4" Real Red Cardstock using 3rd largest Scalloped Die.
- 10. Adhere Basic White panel to center of Real Red panel using Stampin' Seal.
- 11. Place Stampin' Seal on the left back side of the red panel and the middle of the far-right card front panel that opens. Center Real Red panel over card front and adhere. Make sure no adhesive goes past the opening flap or the card won't open.
- 12. Cut 12" of Real Red Sheer Ribbon in half lengthwise so you have 2 long pieces. Tie one piece into a bow and adhere to bow on present using a glue dot. Trim ends if needed.
- 13. Glue a ¼" strip of DSP to left side of envelope and trim if needed. (Optional)
- 14. Enjoy!
